The Governing Board cannot discuss or take legal action on any issues raised during Call to the Public due to restrictions of the Open Meeting Law. However, individual Board members may be permitted to respond to criticism directed to them. Therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.01(H), action taken as a result of public comment on non-agendized topics will be limited to directing staff to study the matter, responding to any criticism, or scheduling the matter for further consideration and decision at a later date. If warranted, issues raised may be placed on the agenda of a future meeting.
